In this beautiful space two eighteenth-century Baroque angels attributed to the Polish sculptor Michael Klahr greet you as you enter. They are among our favorite works from the Thyssen-Bornemisza collection. Complementing these delightful sculptures are original wall inscriptions and traces

SUNSET TERRACE

MONASTERY

The 13 original cells have been tastefully converted into five exquisite suites, each equipped with its own bathroom and windows towards the sea or the medicinal garden. Each room features a unique combination of Renaissance furniture from the Thyssen-Bornemisza collection, bespoke new fur-

niture by Italian designer Paola Lenti, and contemporary art pieces from the TBA21 collection. Wooden ceilings, windows, and floors complemented by historical plaster create a timeless combination of the historical and the contemporary.



MONASTERY

The Morning Glory suite is the largest of our suites and features contemporary artwork by New York-based artist Patricia Treib, *Batignolles* (2015), from the TBA21 collection.

In the morning, as you open your eyes, glorious views of the sparkling sea and neighboring Elaphiti islands will be the first thing you see. In the afternoon, amber rays of sunlight illuminate a beautiful wooden writing desk, where you can

find plenty of creative inspiration. The original graffiti that adorns the wall has been carefully restored and offers an intriguing link to the past.



MONASTERY

Every suite has a unique ambiance, artworks and furniture. The Olive room, with its contrasting dark wood ceiling and soft white walls, and pleasant aromas that drift up from the neighbouring garden, provides a tranquil spot for a lazy morning or a refreshing afternoon snooze, while gazing on

beautiful contemporary artwork by American artist Donald Baechler. The door allows easy access to the cloister's terrace, the perfect place for a family breakfast.



MONASTERY

Our serene bathrooms have been designed with colors complementary to the rooms. The selected shades of green, blue, brown, and grey are modelled on the color palette of the indigenous wild nature of Lopud.

The sinks are contemporary versions of medieval stone washbasins, some of which have been restored and are part of the monastery's interior.



LA VILLA

In addition to the five suites in the monastery, Lopud 1483 offers additional accommodation in four en-suite bedrooms in a nearby villa. All rooms are well equipped to a three-star standard.

Two of them overlook a beautiful private Renaissance garden, typical of 15th century villas in the Dubrovnik area, and the other two have views of the sea.

The rooms are simple and peaceful, tastefully decorated with mellow, pastel colours. Help yourself to the collection of art books in the lounge downstairs, ideal for perusing in the shade of the large magnolia tree in the garden. What more does one need for a relaxing holiday?
